

Staff Clothing List



What do I need? What should I wear? What will I bring? These are questions we are often asked by staff members. This page is designed to give you some clothing and equipment suggestions for your stay at camp as a staff member. This list is not intended to be inclusive but rather a guide to get you started. We suggest that you mark your clothes with nametapes or indelible markers.

Dress Code There is no uniform for staff at our camps but staff are expected to be dressed appropriately. Shirts with alcohol related or inappropriate language or slogans, revealing shirts, skirts or shorts, bikini's and gang related paraphernalia are prohibited. Shirts must be worn in the dining hall and do-rags can be worn inside sleeping areas only.

Open Toed Shoes For insurance and safety reasons staff are not permitted to wear open toed shoes while working.

Attention Waterfront Counselors/Lifeguards Lifeguards **must** wear red shorts and a red hat when life guarding. I strongly suggest that you bring several red shorts and red hats with you to camp.

Bed Linens Camp will supply blankets and a pillow for staff. We suggest that staff bring their own sheets and pillow cases. International staff are an exception and will be provided with sheets. Please bring a sleeping bag if you have one as these come in very handy both during camp and for traveling afterwards.

Laundry Once per week the camp will do your laundry along with campers' laundry. This is an industrial style laundry and is not for delicate items. The camp cannot assume any responsibility for lost or damaged items.
